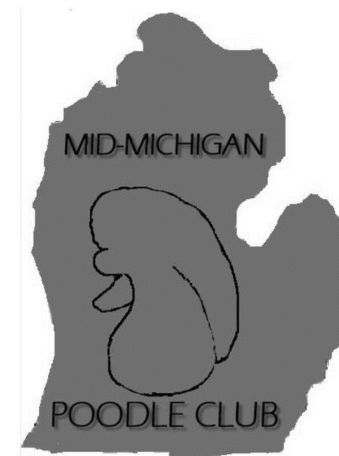

REMINDER:

(1) Please do NOT drive in the fields with your car, truck, minivan or SUV. Vehicles are restricted to the outside edges of the fields, mowed paths and the two-track. ("Quads" are acceptable.)

(2) Please pick up any trash including food and drink containers, spent primer shells, blind ribbons, etc.

Remember that we are able to use the property at the owners discretion. If we are unable to comply with his requests we may lose access to these grounds.

The WC/WCX test is open to Standard and Miniature poodles .

Poodle Club of America rules will be used.

Birds: Fresh killed ducks will be used for all Poodles. Pigeons, chukars, or other PCA approved game birds will be substituted for ducks on land retrieves only if a sufficient number of ducks are not available, and the same type of bird will be used for all dogs.

Prizes: Each qualifying dog will receive a rosette ribbon and duck band. Qualifying WC and WCX Poodles are eligible for Poodle Club of America certificates. All awards will be given out at the end of the day!

Directions: From I-96: Take Ex133 onto MI-59 north. Turn left onto Oak Grove Rd., 4.1 miles. Turn right onto Faussett Rd after 5.4 miles. Go 3.5 miles and the destination is on your left. Take the right fork in the drive.

HOTEL / MOTEL REGULATIONS Notice to Dog Owners / Exhibitors

- The following rules have been established for the good of all exhibitors concerned. Please follow these rules so that we may continue to use these motels for future events. Thank you for your cooperation.
- Plastic sheeting is to be placed under every crate in hotel rooms. This will keep carpets clean and dry. It is the responsibility of the owner to provide plastic sheeting for each crate.
- Dogs must be crated when owner is out of the room. No exceptions.
- Dogs must be kept on leash at all times while in the hotel, lobbies, or on hotel grounds. Rooms and lobby must be kept clean of dog debris.
- Dogs should be "exercised" in designated areas on hotel premises. Every dog owner is expected to pick up after his or her own dog and dispose waste in designated trash cans. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to find out from the innkeeper where these areas and cans are.
- No dog may be bathed in the hotel due to severe clogging problems in the drain pipes.

Spectators

Please wear dark clothing. Jeans are fine. Hats, shirts, pants etc should not be white or pastels, as these colors will distract the dogs being tested.

Browns, grays, greens, black or khakis are all good colors.

Please park where directed. It is important that the dogs being tested are not distracted by vehicles driving in the test area. Also be conscious that voices, laughter and other sounds carry across bodies of water so kept conversations and activity on a quieter scale so as not to distract the test dogs.

Please bring your own chair, shade and water for yourselves and your dogs.

Please place chairs for viewing the test only in the area instructed by the Marshall. We will have someone available to answer questions as much as possible during the test.

Dogs may not be loose except when running the test.

GUIDELINES

There is some shade available but not necessarily near the test location. Please bring your own shade and water for your dogs. Dogs must be on leash or confined when not running in the test. Electronic collars are not permitted.

Please exercise your dogs away from the test location and those areas where there is likely to be foot traffic. **PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG.** This property is privately owned. **We must leave this facility in exceptional condition. Individuals not cleaning up after their dogs, or themselves, will be asked to leave.** Please park only where directed. Do not drive in areas, or down the private road, unless directed to do so by a member of the trial committee.

Bitches in Season and injured dogs: In heat bitches cannot run and must not be out of vehicles until after all dogs have run, and must remain on leash at all times when not in a vehicle. A refund of the entry fee, less bird costs, will be available for bitches in season. A similar refund for injured dogs will be given if a veterinarian receipt is provided.

Refunds: We will not be able to give refunds except for bitches in season and injured dogs, under the conditions noted above.

This entry is not valid unless the agreement is attached and signed.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to earn prizes or ribbons, I (we) agree to hold the (Mid Michigan Poodle Club), their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance therto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for such claims; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by the law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at anytime resulting from, sustained by any person or persons, including yourself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.
